ALYSSA DINKA

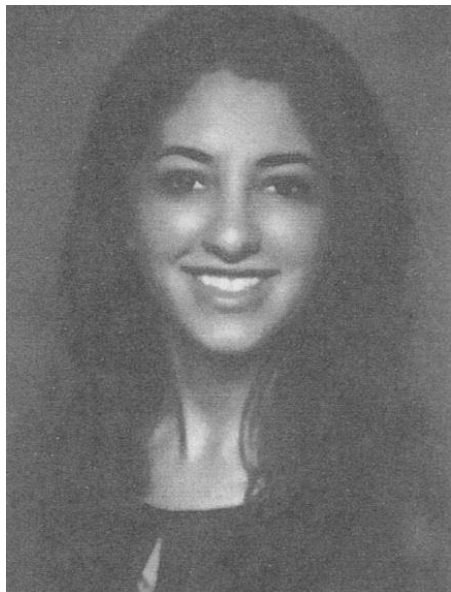
Dance

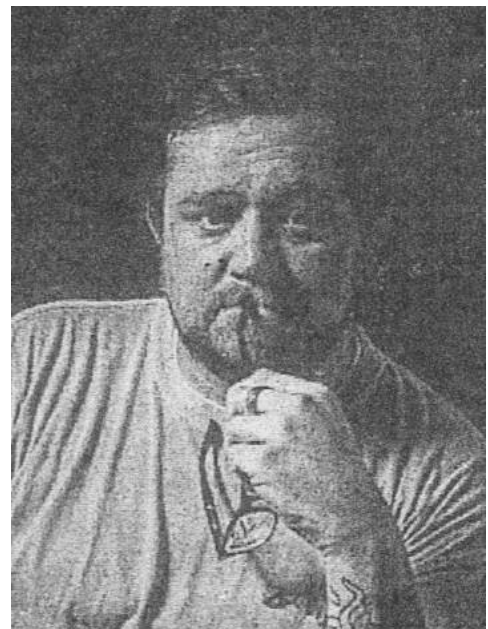


MONICA GONZALEZ

RACHEL HAYDEN

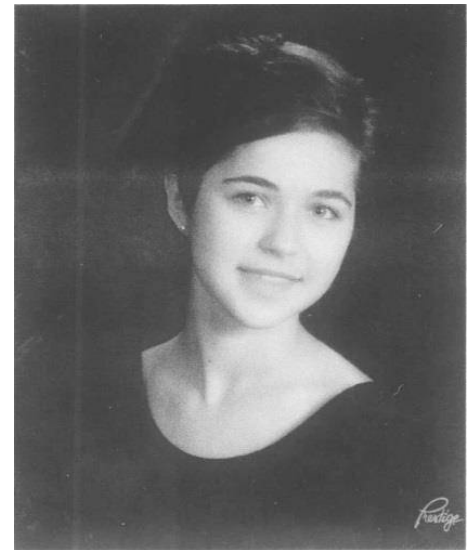
Photography & Graphic Design

SABINO LOPS

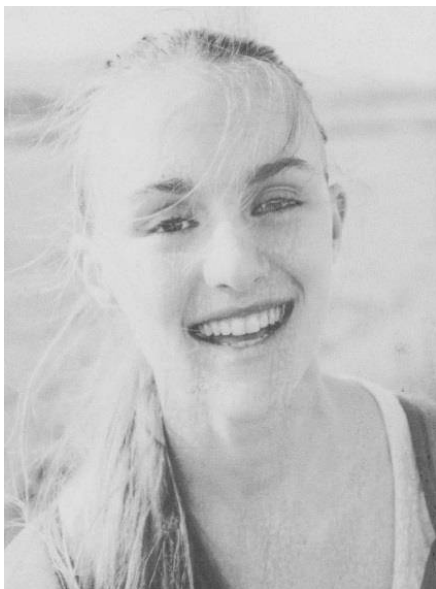

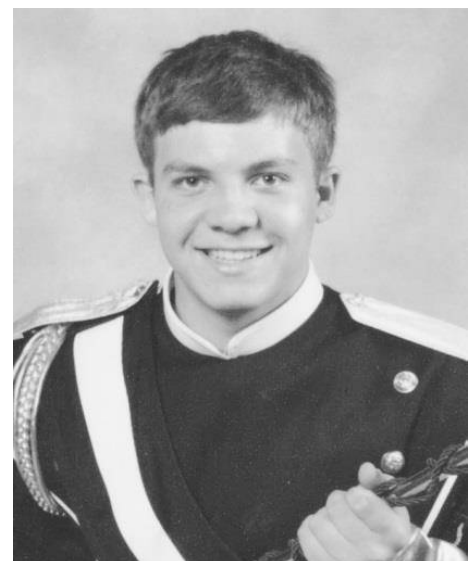


SAMANTHA McVETY

Photography

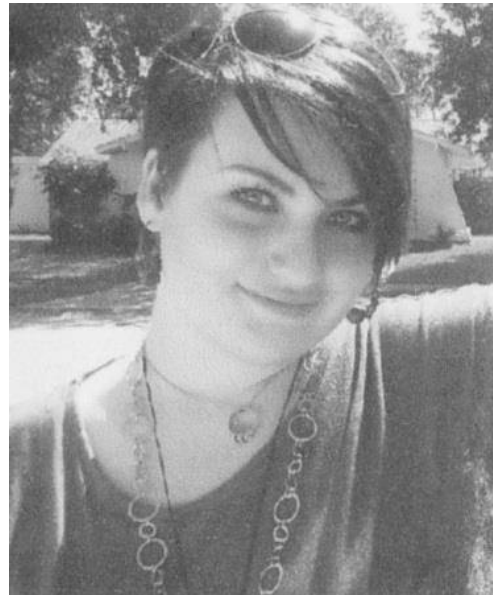
